

Candidacy

Candidacy requirements determine *if and when* students are eligible to take upper division (≥ 3000 numbered) business courses or be a "candidate." Students are generally accepted into LSBE as pre-candidates.

The requirements to obtain candidacy are completing ALL the premajor courses (outlined below) with 3 different grade point averages at or above the minimum levels.

Those GPAs are:

- 1) **Cumulative GPA 2.6** minimum (all courses, from all institutions combined)
- 2) **U of MN GPA 2.6** minimum (all courses within the U of MN system)
- 3) **Pre-major GPA 2.0** minimum (see course list below)

A = 4, B = 3, **B- = 2.667**, C+ = 2.333, C = 2
